- Q1 The RFP states that “retention is to be tracked and reported even when occurring outside of the funding period” and “the retention phase begins and last for the duration of the County projects”. Does that mean all participants would be reported on quarterly in I-Trac for the duration of the construction? How long is the construction projected to last?
- A1 **The County projects will last until winter of 2019; exact end dates are not available at this time. Yes, the participants must be reported on quarterly in I-Trac for the entire period.**
- Q2 Would awarded contractors be required to attend LMCOC meetings as part of the services provided?
- A2 **Contractors will not need to plan to attend the regular LMCOC meetings; Worksystems staff can report out to the committee on the project performance as needed. If it’s determined that a contractor presentation to the committee would be beneficial, Worksystems staff will coordinate with contractor staff in a timely manner to schedule that.**
