## Washington County Workforce Development Request for Proposals

### Questions and Answers

#### June 17, 2024

- Q1 Should applicants identify target performance measures for the Data Points table shown on page 4 of the Request for Proposals?  
A1 **No, applicants do not need to submit measures for the Data Points.**
- Q2 Will the resulting contract require awardees to develop and provide paid work experience with at least 30 clients enrolled, per the performance requirements table on page 4 of the Request for Proposals? If so, will the awardee be required to provide the work experience wages?  
A2 **The resulting contract will not require the awardee to provide paid work experience; the paid work experience will be provided through referring participants to PDX Metro Works.**
- Q3 Are institutions eligible to claim their full federally-negotiated indirect rate?  
A3 **Yes.**

#### May 28, 2024

- Q1 Are all clients receiving services under the resulting contract required to meet all of the requirements listed in the Request for Proposals page 5 AND also be receiving services through Washington County's Supporting Housing Services (SHS) department?  
A1 **Yes, the contractor will be working with clients referred from Washington County's Supportive Housing Services, and will be working with Washington County Supportive Housing Services.**
- Q2 Given the available funding, will there be more than one award?  
A2 **We anticipate making one award.**
